What is it?

Stroke is the fourth leading cause of death in the United States. To address this problem, all healthcare providers, as well as the general public, should be educated about the warning signs and effective, time-dependent treatment of stroke.

Stroke Prehospital Care Online is an interactive online course designed to increase healthcare providers' knowledge about stroke and demonstrate potential stroke-related signs.
